Mid-Autumn Celebration In Year 2002

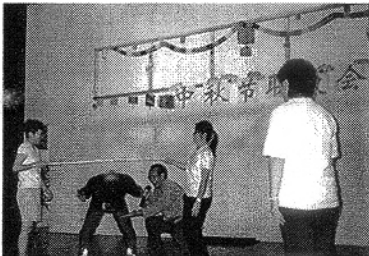


This year, we decided to celebrate mid-Autumn Festival on the 15th September 2002.
